

PARTING SHOT

ALAN LOMAX, 1915-2002 SAM BALLARD (OLD DAD), NEW IBERIA, LOUISIANA JUNE, 1934

This photograph of musician Sam Ballard is one of 400 snapshot images made in the course of sound recording expeditions carried out by John Avery Lomax, his wife, Ruby Terrill Lomax, and their son, Alan Lomax between 1934 and 1950 for the Archive of American Folk-Song. The photographs comprise the Lomax Collection in the Library of Congress, which depicts African American, Mexican American, and white musicians, singers and dancers, primarily in the southern United States (Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Texas, and Virginia) and the Bahamas (Nassau, Andros Island, and Cat Island). In addition to posed portraits, images in the Collection show musicians performing in various settings: at home, in concert, and while performing prison labor outdoors.

With their recording expeditions, the Lomaxes were instrumental (no pun intended—really!) in preserving American folk music and blues traditions.
