THE LIFE OF AN INDEPENDENT PHOTOJOURNALIST

An independent photographer with nearly 30 years of professional experience, Wade Payne has shot images that have been seen around the world. His photographs have appeared in *Sports Illustrated*, *ESPN the Magazine*, *The Washington Post*, the *Los Angeles Times*, *The Boston Globe*, *The Denver Post*, *USA TODAY* and many others. His images have been distributed by The Associated Press, Thomson-Reuters, and the European Press Agency.

Over the course of his photojournalism career Wade has also served the education field. For several years, students were fortunate to learn sports, studio and flash photography from him in the University of Tennessee's Professional & Personal Development Photography Program. He serves on the Mississippi State Community College Advisory Board for the Photography Department in Knoxville, Tennessee.

His portrait of NBA Hall of Fame player Earl Francis Lloyd, the first African-American to play in the National Basketball Association was selected as the centerpiece for a collector's edition art piece that hung in the office of President of the United States, Barack Obama, the Smithsonian Institute Museum, National Civil Rights Museum, Library of Congress, National Basketball Association Hall of Fame and the corporate offices of the National Collegiate Athletic Association.

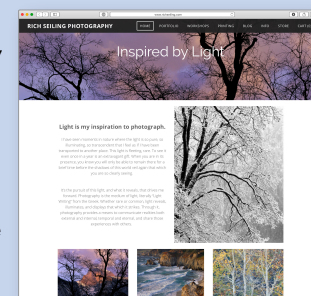

Master printer and NPC member, Rich Seiling, recently brought out two new sites to better serve photographers.

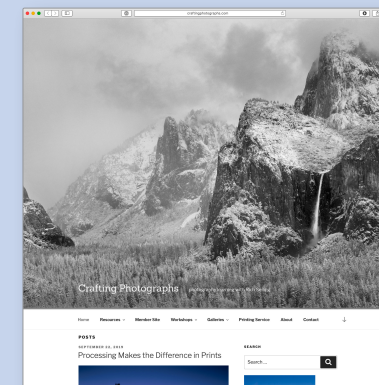
For those of you who (wisely!) follow Rich at RichSeiling.com, be sure to check out the two sites he just launched—



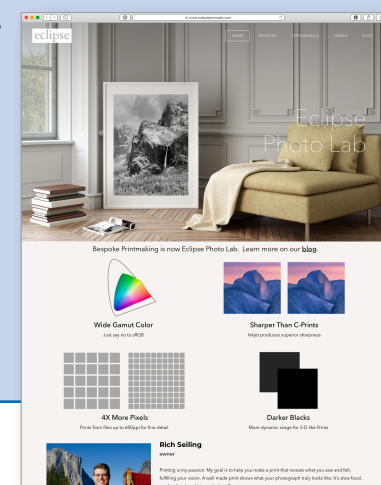
CraftingPhotographs.com is the new home for all
