# Jim Zuckerman - Guest Speaker on September 21st



Jim Zuckerman is one of the world's best-known nature, wildlife, and travel photographers. His work has been sold in dozens of countries around the world in commercial, editorial and fine art venues. Jim is also a respected photo educator, and he is the author of 14 books on a wide range of photographic subjects. He leads international photo tours to exotic destinations such as Ethiopia, Indonesia, Turkey, India, and Namibia.

Jim's photographic pursuits are unusually diverse. In addition to nature and travel work, he also shoots children, fashion, electron photomicrography, and he is considered a master at creating conceptual imagery.

Jim has been a contributing editor for Photographic Magazine for 38 years. His images, articles, and photo features have been published in scores of books and magazines including Time-Life books, publications of the National Geographic Society, Omni Magazine, National Wildlife, and Conde Nast Traveler. His work has been used in advertising and packaging design as well as in calendars, posters, greeting cards, and corporate brochures. Jim also teaches online for Betterphoto.com and conducts Photoshop workshop in his home.
