4. Image size 850 pixels on the longest side at 75PPI quality.

5. **Images must be submitted to Brent Wright by Tuesday, June 2** to be included in the slide show.

6. Please use WeTransfer.com to send Brent your images.

7. When you send them please send Brent an e-mail at bwrightback@comcast.net to let him know you are transferring images to him. Brent will send you an acknowledgement e-mail back once he's downloaded them. If you don't hear back from him within two days contact him—don't assume he got your images.


